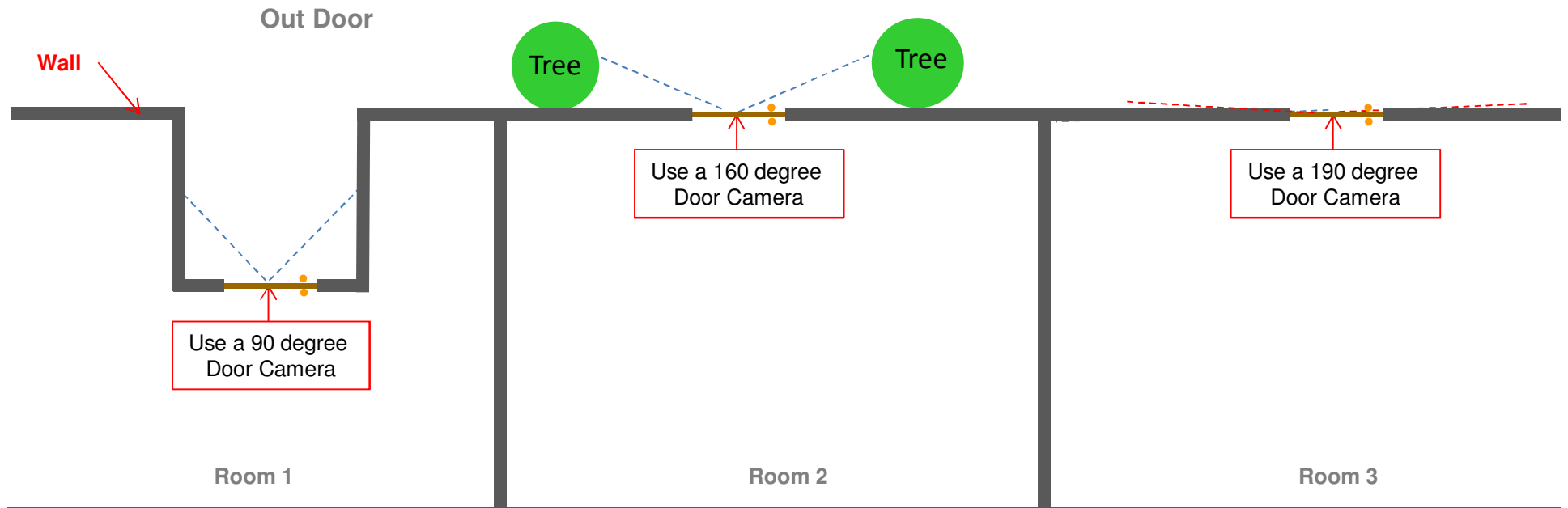


How to select a Door Camera with a proper viewing angle for your door?

Answer:

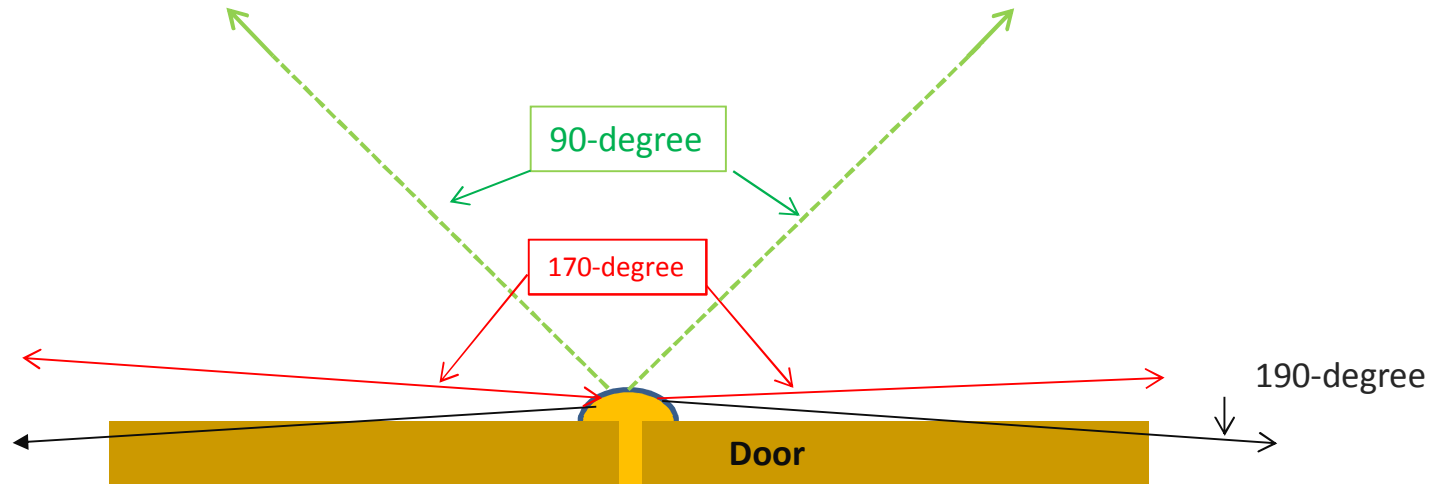
Check if there is any tree, pillar outside of your front door, and then decide the viewing angle of the door camera. Please refer to following diagram as an example.



Note:

- For a door camera with a wider viewing angle you can see everything in front of your door, however their video image will become smaller comparing to a narrow viewing angle door camera.
- For example, thing viewing inside a 170 degree camera, will become about half size viewing from a 90 degree camera.
- In case you like to see thing distance away, we would recommend use a narrow viewing angle camera for a clear view.

Viewing Angle of a Peephole Door Camera



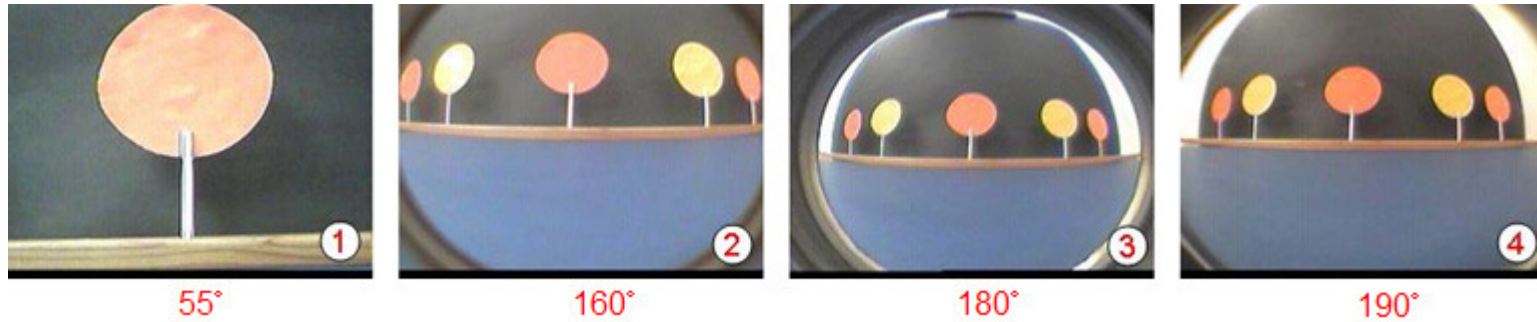
For a door camera with a wider viewing angle you can see everything in front of your door, however their video image will become smaller comparing to a narrow viewing angle camera.

For example, thing viewing inside a 170 degree camera, will become about half size viewing from a 90 degree camera.

In case you like to see thing distance away (i.e. 5 feet away), we would recommend use a narrow viewing angle camera for a clear view.
